### RNLI vital statistics

- The RNLI maintains over 230 lifeboat stations around the UK and the Republic of Ireland
- The RNLI has over 330 lifeboats at it's stations
- We have over 4,500 volunteer crew members
- In 2007 the lifeboats launched 8,141 times and rescued 7,834 people
- RNLI lifeguards patrol over 70 beaches
- 9,883 people were assisted in 2007 by beach lifeguards and a total of 62 lives were saved



#### The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that take part in the Direct Debit Scheme.
- The efficiency and security of the Scheme is monitored and protected by your own Bank or Building Society.
- If the amounts to be paid or the payment dates change, the RNLI will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited, or as otherwise agreed.
- If an error is made by the RNLI or your Bank or Building Society, you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your Bank or Building Society. Please also send a copy of your letter to us.
